## **DELEGATIONS**

Shannon Statham, HCIS Primary Care Manager, Interior Health, described the Community Paramedicine Initiative and explained that the objective is to provide a competent, sustainable paramedic presence to respond to medical emergencies, bridge gaps in patients' health care plans with local health care providers and build on existing skills of primary or advanced care paramedics to improve health service delivery. Ms. Statham stated the implementation will be over 4 years, noting phase one is to build on the competencies and skill sets of existing paramedics and phase two is to expand the program to additional communities.

**Todd Mastel**, Director Business Support, Interior Health, reviewed the capital funding request for the 2016/2017 fiscal year advising that the funding request is to ensure staff and physicians continue to provide high quality healthcare services.

**Karen Bloemink,** Executive Director Hospitals & Community Integrated Services, Interior Health East, reviewed the recent changes to the Interior Health leadership structure. She explained that Interior Health's goals are to improve health and wellness, deliver high quality care, ensure sustainable health care, and cultivate an engaged workforce and a healthy workplace.
